# What is the Sports Premium?

The Department for Education (DfE) are spending over £450 million on improving physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools over the 3 academic years. The funding was first issued for the academic year 2013/2014 and will it continue over the academic years 2015/2016 and 2016/2017. The funding will be allocated directly to primary school's to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all pupils.

## Our school allocation

Our school has been awarded £3679.00 for the academic year 2016-2017 (this is confirmed to the end of August 2016). We are awaiting information as to whether this will be extended beyond August.

The money will be used to help provide for the following initiatives:
