
PRESCHOOL UNDER 2'S

Our story is 'Rumble in the Jungle' so we decided to take turns and draw our favourite animal from the story on the magic glow board. Roar...... I wonder what that could be?




NURSERY

We are learning about dinosaurs! We studied real fossils and discussed the shapes and textures with our talk partners. Then we used salt dough to create our own dinosaur bones!




YEAR 1H

In Art we created abstract collages using magazine extracts and drawing freehand lines. They were inspired by Henri Rousseau's jungle paintings.




YEAR 4

In our geography lessons this week, we learnt about some features of human geography in our local area using Google Maps. We used the satellite view to see the different types of land use and learnt about the different purposes of the buildings, including tehservice industry (retail, health and education) housing (terraced houses and flats). We learnt that our settlement type is part of a capital city and that we have lots of different links to other places, including roads and different types of transport.



YEAR 5

In Maths we have been learning about the four quadrants, reflection and translation. We learnt about the X and Y axis and how to write coordinates. Can you work out which of the shapes below is plotted at (-2 , 3), (-7 , 3), (-7 , 8) and (-5 , 8)? Has shape A been reflected or translated to position B?



YEAR 6

In Science we have been learning about forces. We used slow motion recording on the iPad to help us see the effect of upthrust in water. It was both interesting and fun, we did get a tad wet too!
