

KS2 SPELLING WORKSHOP - 25.04.19

Introduction:

- The government stipulates which spellings children should learn from Years 1-6 in the appendix here.
- Children are tested on these spellings in Y2/Y6 in their SATs tests. This makes up half of their Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar test score.

Why teach spelling?

- So children can write accurately. If children can't spell, they won't be able to write successfully.
- So children's reading will improve. Teaching children to spell means that their reading levels soar as well.

Where can I find my child's spellings?

- Using the information from this document, each year your child will be given the opportunity to revise previously learnt spellings as well as learn new spellings.
- These can be accessed on the school website.
- Words with similar spelling patterns are grouped together in a list & these are to be learnt alongside the commonly misspelled words click here for more information
- Spellings will be tested weekly and you should be receiving both the scores & any incorrect spellings in the test so these can continue to be learnt.
